House Rules

Food and drink can only be consumed in the foyer and should only be brought for small children. Gum should be placed in trash cans near the entrances of building.

Silence cell phones and other electronics before the start of Mass.

Babies and small children can utilize the foyer, if a child is fussy, crying or needs food/drink during Mass. They are welcome in the church pews, but parents should take them to the foyer if they become a distraction to others.

Hats should be removed in sanctuary and can left above coat rack in the foyer.

Be respectful of our renovated sanctuary by gently lowering kneelers, returning books to the hymn racks, and keeping your shoes off the kneelers and pews.

Non-monetary donations (including flowers) should be approved by the pastor before bringing them to the parish.


